



Below, you will find detailed information regarding the state testing beginning at the end of April.

CAASPP 2024 State Testing Information

I wanted to inform you of the important dates for our upcoming California Assessment of Student Performance Smarter Balanced Assessment for students in grades third through eighth. As you know, each spring, the 3rd through 8th grade students in the Buckeye Union School District participate in a series of state assessments. These assessments are designed to evaluate student progress toward mastery of the Common Core Content Standards. The results of these assessments serve as the basis of California's educational accountability system. (See www.caaspp.org for more information) The following tests are part of the California Assessments of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) system; these tests will be administered during the time frames listed below:

Smarter Balanced (SBA)

The Smarter Balanced assessments (English Language Arts and mathematics) will again be administered this spring. These assessments measure critical thinking with questions that ask students to demonstrate their research, writing, and problem solving skills. The tests consist of both Computer Adaptive questions and Performance Tasks which allow students to not only demonstrate skills, but apply their learning. California Science Standards Test

Students in grades 5 and 8 will take the SBA Science test this year. Visit the California Department of Education website to learn more http://www.cde.ca.gov/ta/tg/ca/

California Alternate Assessment Test

The CAA is a grade level assessment for students with severe cognitive disabilities in grades three (3) through eight (8) in English Language Arts and mathematics. This test will give students the opportunity to demonstrate their achievement of the Common Core State Standards (CCSS) by taking a test commensurate with their abilities. Students with disabilities who are not able to take part in this assessment will take the new California Alternative Assessment (CAA) Test. This online test will be administered during the SBA testing window.

Physical Fitness Test

Students in grades 5 and 7 will take the FITNESSGRAM which is the physical fitness test used in California. The test consists of five performance components: aerobic capacity, abdominal strength, trunk strength, upper body strength and flexibility.

Middle School Schedule during testing

During the first two weeks of testing we have modified the middle school schedule so that all testing occurs during the morning before lunch. Students will still attend each class every day, but some periods will be longer than others during certain days to accommodate the testing schedule. The week of May 20th - May 24th, we are allotting for test make ups, and the schedule will return to normal during this week.

Notice Of Right To Opt Out Of CAASPP SBA Testing

Parents/guardians have the right to "opt out" their student from the California Assessment of Student Performance Smarter Balanced Assessment. The procedure for the parent or legal guardian to request that a student not participate in one or all parts of the CAASPP, is to write a letter to the Principal of the school specifying which sections they are requesting the student not participate in; the Principal then informs the District CAASPP coordinator and the student will be given an alternative local assessment such as in class curriculum based assessments, FastBridge, chapter tests, et cetera, that the teacher is able to gauge the students' knowledge of the California Content Standards. A letter must be received by the office on or before April 12, 2024. If a family "opts out", they will not receive a score report unless there was only a portion of the assessment that the student participated in.

I encourage parents to support their children's effort to do their very best on these important assessments. Parents can help by making sure their child gets plenty of sleep each night, providing a nutritious breakfast each morning, reviewing the practice tests (https://www.caaspp.org/practice-and-training/index.html) with their child, and ensuring their child makes it to school on time. It is expected that the district assesses all children. Accordingly, parents are asked not to schedule doctor or dentist appointments during school testing days.

Lastly, our students will be incentivized each day to win prizes for showing the "E" in "RISE", showing effort each day they are testing. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions.
