A)

1. Study vocabulary for Unit 7-1 on p 413
2. Translate pp 392 & 393
3. Listen to Victoria & Esperanza on p 395 and Complete activity #4 on p 396
4. Read and listen Victor Espronceda's biography on p 407 and write 8 questions about his life and then answer them.

B)

1. Study vocabulary for Unit 7-2 on p 439
2. Translate pp 418 & 419
3. Read and listen p 421 and answer questions about the reading in act. # 4 p 422

C)

1. Study Vocabulary for U 8-1 on p 473
2. Listen, read and translate pp 452 & 453
3. Listen and read the dialogue on p 465 & 466 and answer the questions in act. # 18 on p 466.

D)

1. Study vocabulary U 8-2 on p499
2. Read and listen pp 478 & 479
3. Complete act. # 1 on p 480
