I am becoming increasingly concerned about our ability to effectuate a comfortable learning environment for our students and staff later this week. The forecast is calling for increasingly hot temperatures and high humidity, which will cause many of our classroom environments to reach temperatures above 85 degrees.

To that end, I am making Thursday a half day of school for elementary and middle school students. Middle School students will dismiss at 10:30 a.m. and Elementary School Students will dismiss at 11:30 a.m. All high school Regents exams will proceed as scheduled. These exams are administered in air conditioned rooms.

Friday, June 21 was already scheduled as a half day for elementary and middle school students. The 5th grade Moving Up Ceremony will proceed as planned as it is occurring in the auditorium which is air conditioned. The high school Regents exams will proceed as scheduled.

Please note that schools are closed tomorrow in recognition of the Juneteenth holiday.
