Chicora Dress Code

From the Principal's Pen.....

Parents, we need your help! Please be sure that your young child comes to school ready to learn. This means that your child is dressed appropriately for the day and has needed school supplies. When you feel good about how you look and know you are prepared for the day, you usually experience success. The same is true for our boys and girls. This support will make a big difference in your child's performance. Thank you for all that you do each day with your children at Chicora School.

Children are expected to follow our school dress code daily.

School clothing should meet these guidelines below.

- Boys and girls should wear red, white, light blue, navy blue or yellow shirts with collars.
- Navy blue or khaki pants (not blue jeans) or shorts for boys.
- Navy blue or khaki pants (not blue jeans) <u>knee length</u> skirts, skorts, shorts, or jumpers for girls.
- If clothing has a belt loop or a size larger than normal, students are to wear a belt.
- Shoes and socks daily. *No open toe(s) shoe at school,* (This is a safety concern).



We want our students to wear their clothes with pride. This means that:

- Clothing will **fit the child**. No baggy clothes at school.
- Shirts and blouses will be **tucked in** at all times. (This is a safety concern).
- Shirts and blouses will be plain.... **NO writing, designs or non-school logos.**

It is our school policy and a component of our school to implement the behavior, **S.O.A.R.**-Safety, Order, Responsibility and Respect. During school hours students must wear their school uniform as stated unless permission not to wear has been approved by the principal. Permission to wear "Cool Clothes" will be granted in the form of a ticket to inform the parent if the student has permission to wear "cool clothes" or not. If the parent fails to have the student in uniform, one or more of the offense will be implemented:

1 st Offense	Warning to the student (notification sent in folder)
2 nd Offense	Your child will have silence lunch and will not go to recess
3 rd Offense	A parental conference will be required to return child to school
