1. One of the ways a SC student is considered College Ready includes earning at least 6 credit hours with a minimum of a C+ in any approved course offered for College Credit/Dual Enrollment

**During the 2021-22 school year, 100% of the Comp Sci A and 92% of the Comp Sci Principles students earned 3 or higher on their AP Exam making them College Ready, and 1040 PLTW students scored "Accomplished" or higher on their EOC and are now eligible for Dual Credit weighting!*

2. Students may also be considered College Ready by earning 1020+ on the SAT or 20+ on the ACT exam, submitting unofficial transcripts, and completing appropriate homeschool paperwork
