



O Arrival and Dismissal

<u>Arrival</u>

All **4PK-2nd grade students** will enter at the main entrance of school and must be to school by 8:00.

- Students can be dropped off as early as 7:15.
- Breakfast will be served from 7:30-8:10.
- Buses unload students at 7:40.

All 3PK students will enter at the side door at 9:00 for the AM program or 12:30 for the PM program.

<u>Dismissal</u>

Dismissal changes must be made **before 1:00pm**. Parent pick-up will begin at 2:15pm each day at the following doors based on last name. Please make sure we have the name of the person picking up and that person has a **driver's license for identification**.

- <u>A-C</u> at the ELC doorway on the parking lot side
- <u>D-H</u> at the back playground door
- I-Q at the first door on the left in the driveway between the HS & PS
- <u>R-Z</u> at the second door on the left in the driveway between the HS & PS

All 3PK AM and PM students will exit at the side door at 11:30 for the AM program and 3:00 for the PM program. Our 3PK students are dropped off and picked up in the small Primary Bus Loop during the following times: 8:45-9:00, 11:20-11:35, 12:20-12:30, and 2:50-3:05. Please consider parking in a different location so that you aren't trapped in the loop.

Summer Electronic Benefits Transfer

Summer EBT is a new program that provides low-income families with food benefits to help cover the cost of groceries when school is out of session. Summer is the time when many children lose access to free meals they get at school. Most eligible children will receive Summer EBT food benefits automatically; however, some families may need to apply.

Enrollment


Many families will get Summer EBT automatically if they are getting other benefits, but some families may need to apply.

• <u>Automatically enrolled</u>: If the child participated in SNAP, TA, FDPIR, Medicaid* or was reported to a Regional Information Center as eligible for free/reduced-price meals by their school anytime in the 2023-24 school year, they will be automatically enrolled in the Summer EBT program. These families do not need to fill out a separate Summer EBT application. NYS estimates that 85% of children who are eligible for Summer EBT will be automatically enrolled.

• <u>Application needed</u>: If the child has not been reported by their school or district of enrollment to the NYS Education Department as eligible for free/reduced-price meals by their school but is income eligible and attends an NSLP participating school, they can get Summer EBT by filling out a simple online application with OTDA.




