All **4PK-2nd grade students** will enter at the main entrance of school and must be to school by 8:00.

- Students can be dropped off as early as 7:15.

- R-Z at the second door on the left in the driveway between the HS & PS



Before the Event What and When to Eat

What and when you eat before competition can influence how you perform. It is also a highly individualized decision based on previous experience, physical comfort and emotional or mental considerations. In general, you should maintain a high complex carbohydrate, low-fat throughout the training period. Then, chose a pre-competition meal that works well for you. Include complete carbohydrates and fluids, and limit fat. Eat 2 to 4 hours prior to the event and eat familiar, carbohydrate-rich foods to avoid intestinal distress. Drink ample amounts of water, milk or juice with the meal. Substitute frequent carbohydrate-rich snacks and fluids for full meals if it makes vou more comfortable. caloric drinks up to 45 minutes before the event but do drink plenty of water).
