<u>Polo Shirt</u>	any SOLID color	SRDS logo or small/no logo
<u>Oxford, Button Down Shirts</u>	any SOLID color	SRDS logo or small/no logo
<u>Turtle Necks</u>	any SOLID color	SRDS logo or small/no logo
<u>Sweaters:</u> cardigans, v necks, crewnecks, ¾ zips, polar fleece, henleys	any SOLID color	SRDS logo or small/no logo
<u>Pants, or Yoga Pants w/Pockets, Skirts, Skorts</u> (no denim, no leggings, no sweat pants)	tan, navy, black	none
<u>Tights, Leggings (leggings can only be worn under a dress, shorts or skirt)</u>	Solid color	none
<u>Dresses/Skirts*</u>	Any SOLID color, must be mid-thigh length seated and standing.	
<u>Shoes</u>	No slippers or flip flops. Sneakers are permitted Monday-Friday.	
<u>Socks</u>	any color (solid or patterned)	
<u>Belts:</u> optional	any	
<u>Shorts</u> (no denim)	tan, black, or navy (solid only dress shorts). Board shorts, swimwear, and athletic shorts are not permitted. Shorts may be no shorter than mid-thigh when the student is standing and seated.	
<u>Spirit Wear</u>	purchased from Land's End* or SRDS Spirit Store	SRDS logo

Additional Dress Code Information 2023-2024

- **PE:** If students wish to change for PE they may purchase PE uniforms, or bring shorts and tshirt. They must wear athletic footwear on PE days. [Athletic Gear](#)
- **Rebel Fridays:** Students are required to wear Rebel or SRDS Spirit Wear. They may wear jeans (any color without holes) or athletic leisure pants (ie- joggers, proper length shorts, sweatpants, leggings) any **solid color**, on Rebel Fridays **if they are wearing Rebel Gear**.
 - Tops of any type should cover entire midriff
 - **Hoodies:** Students may wear SRDS or REBELS or solid colored hoodies any day of the week. Note that “hoods” should not be on their heads but lay neatly on their backs.
 - **Outerwear:** Outerwear may NOT be worn during the school day unless it is a SRDS/Rebels logo fleece.
 - **Dress Down Days:** Several dress down days may be given to students during the school year. These days are a chance for students to take a break from the dress code expectations. Standards of classroom appropriate attire still apply to these looser requirements. On these days, students may wear clothing of their choice as long as their selections are not ripped, torn, do not contain offensive logos, are within good taste and are school appropriate. Tank tops, midriff tops, hats, and pajama pants are not permitted.

*Some information is presented on the Lands’ End website for Rebel Gear and other Dress code appropriate items. Name tags should be sewn into the garments to ensure identity. Any uniform attire not listed in the current catalog and from a previous year is acceptable.
