### Parking Contract and Regulations

1. Permits are non-transferable. Only the student assigned to the sticker and spot may use the spot. Family members or friends may not use another student's spot.
2. If someone is parked in your assigned spot, park your vehicle in the **student reserved** parking. Report this to a parking lot staff member or the Dean's office.
3. The Deans' Office must be notified if another vehicle is driven to school.
4. Students are to enter school upon arrival to the lot and are to exit the lot immediately after dismissal. Loitering is not permitted.
5. The campus speed limit is 5 miles per hour. Careless driving, racing, fast or reckless driving, squealing of tires, and the playing of loud music is prohibited.
6. All vehicles must have a current parking permit properly displayed and permanently affixed to the window.
7. Student vehicles may be subject to search if there are reasonable grounds to believe there may be contraband (including any weapons, stolen items, or intoxicants) present in the vehicle. By applying to park on campus, parent and student give consent for the vehicle to be searched.
8. Any accident must be reported immediately to the Deans' Office and Palos Hills Police Department.
9. Students on Administrative Probation or other discipline violations may have their parking privileges suspended or revoked.
10. Students are responsible for locking their vehicles and the contents therein. Stagg High School and District 230 are not responsible for vehicles or their contents.
11. Students are required to notify the Dean's office with all updates to car/driver information (car insurance, new vehicle information, changes to address, etc...)
12. Students must follow traffic patterns while walking or driving in the parking lot.
13. Senior students will have priority in regards to the parking lot. Once Stagg returns to full on-site learning, Seniors will have the 1st opportunity to park vehicles on campus.

**I have read and agree to the above driving and parking regulations. It is also understood that the violation of the driving and parking regulations listed above may result in the suspension/revocation of parking privileges, discipline referral, ticket issued by Palos Hills Police Department, and/or towing of vehicle at owner's expense. Any violation of state or local ordinances may result in a parking ticket issued by the Palos Hills Police Department.**
