Financial Aid

Grants & Scholarships

- Merit-based: academic, talent
- Minority, alumni, 1st generation, Catholic school, etc.
- Need-based
- Outside: local, regional, national

FAFSA - Free Application for Federal Student Aid

- Document that determines eligibility for need-based aid
- Opens October 1st each year
- Pell grant, FSEOG, MAP grant, work-study, Federal Direct Student Loans
