Health Career Connections (HCC) gives you hands-on exposure to real health care settings while you're still in high school.



Participate in Health Career Connections

- 1. Get prepared and apply (Before March 1 / Junior Year)**
Juniors, talk with your parent / guardian, then complete / submit the Career-Based Learning application (available in the School Counseling Office or MHS website).
- 2. Interview with HCC partners (Spring / Junior Year)**
After your application is complete, you may be scheduled for an interview with program partners, such as MACCI.
- 3. Optional: Register for Nursing Assistant through the technical college (Junior Year or Senior Year)**
As an HCC student, tuition and books are paid for by the school district; students are responsible for paying for other expenses (Mrs. Fredrick can assist with the course registration process).
- 4. Participate in HCC orientation (Late Spring / Junior Year)**
Attend HCC orientation, making sure you have the information you need to be successful in this course.
- 5. Participate in scheduled rotations during 2 MHS Periods**
MACCI will provide you with a schedule of rotations to learn about a variety of health careers at area health care facilities. Students must be able to transport themselves to local health care facilities. HCC is 2 credits at MHS.
- 6. Complete evaluations of each rotation and receive feedback**
You will have the opportunity to evaluate each rotation and receive feedback about your performance.
