DC Work-Based Learning I

- 1.5 credits
 - 0.5 Face-to-Face / Online Instruction (students must opt-in to earn DC)
 - 1.0 + Work Experience
 - 10 hours / week or more
 - Up to 2 periods / semester for School-to-Work Work Time (may be revoked at quarter if "F / I" grade in any course)
- Course Topics
 - Employability Skills
 - Resumes + Cover Letters
 - Interviewing Skills
 - Career Exploration
 - Post-Secondary Options
 - Health + Safety @ Work
- Pre-Reqs
 - Earned 20+ high school credits by end of Junior Year
 - Approved employment with an area employer + Training Agreement
 - Good standing at MHS
 - Students must be able to transport themselves to work

Work-Based Learning II

- 1.5 credits
 - 0.5 Face-to-Face / Online Instruction
 - 1.0 + Work Experience
 - 10 hours / week or more
 - Up to 2 periods / semester for School-to-Work Work Time (may be revoked at quarter if "F / I" grade in any course)
- Course Topics
 - Employability Skills
 - Teamwork + Leadership
 - Adapting to Change
 - Entrepreneurship
 - Money + Insurance
 - Work-Life Balance
- Pre-Reqs
 - New to Work-Based Learning? You can enroll directly in Work-Based Learning II – DC Work-Based Learning I is not required.
