## Suggested Supplies for Grade 7

**SUPPLY NOTES:** Students will have the opportunity to use a loaner Chromebook during the school year with parent/guardian permission.

The following items are suggested supplies for seventh graders. There may be teacher or subject-specific additions to the list at the beginning of the school year.

**Please clearly mark all items with the student's name before sending them to school.**

### General Supplies for all classes

- Paper Planner
- Independent Reading Book
- Several #2 Pencils (mechanical or regular)
- Erasers
- Colored pens (Math and World Cultures use colorful Flair pens a lot)
- Colored pencils
- Glue Sticks
- Scissors
- Loose leaf paper (several hundred sheets)
- Pencil pouch that can hold everything.
- Small handheld pencil sharpener (for colored pencils)-- Unless you buy "TWISTABLES" that don't need sharpening
- Three different colored highlighters
- Clear tape

**NOTE:** Classrooms' community supplies are limited, so students may find it's a good idea to choose to purchase their own for school use.

### Math

- 1/2 inch or 1 inch binder for worksheets/notes
- Calculator (scientific or graphing)
- Ruler (with centimeters and inches)

### Language Arts

- Two composition notebooks (no spiral please)
- 2 Folders
- Multi-colored Post-it sticky notes (2 packs)
  - Various sizes are recommended, but 3 x 3 will work

### Science:

- Folder
- Spiral notebook

### World Cultures

- Folder
- 2 Composition/spiral notebooks - they will fill up one, so they need to keep the second one at the ready.

**It is recommended that students have different color notebooks for each class - this helps with organization**
