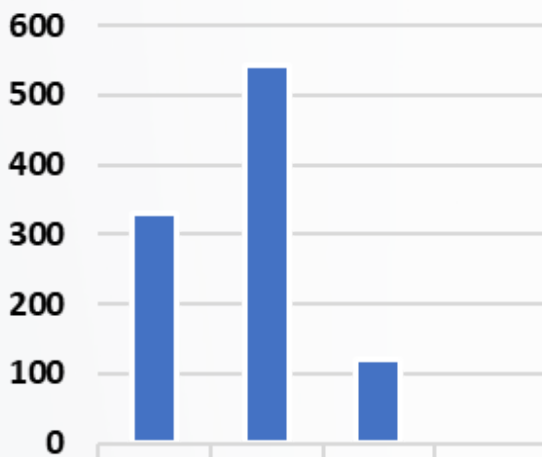

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

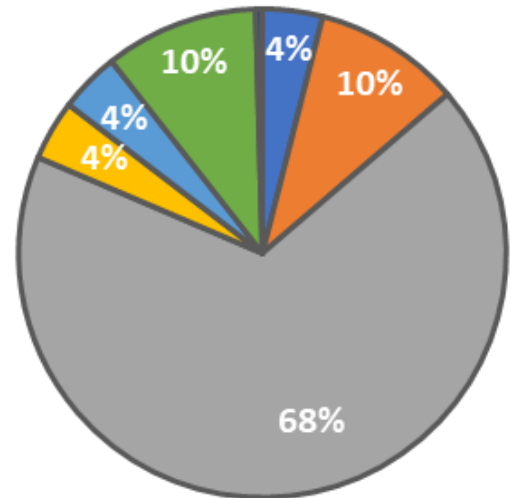
- 326 Students earned 3 or 4 units in a single program to be a state CTE Completer
