

Spanish 1 Honors- Summer Assignment 2024

¡Bienvenidos a español 1 Honors! This is a demanding, fast-paced course of study which prepares students for the AP Spanish Language course pathway and examination. Students will be expected to speak, read, write, and comprehend Spanish in class at a Novice-low or Novice-Mid proficiency level. Major grammatical structures and a wide array of vocabulary will be taught as well.

We will work and all 4 skills: reading comprehension, writing, speaking ability, and listening comprehension, in addition to enhancing your understanding of the Hispanic world.

Your goal this summer is to be exposed to Spanish to help you prepare for the class. Your summer assignment is not mandatory but certainly recommended. The assignment is online through a website or application called Duolingo. This is a free service, please do not pay for anything unless you want to.

Please create an account (a new one, if you already have one) use your **NAME and LAST NAME**. Once you create your account please go to your profile, then go to **Settings** and there you will find the “**Progress Sharing**” option where you will type in the class code **KCXEGX** Once you join the Duolingo classroom go to “Learn” on top left menu. Your assignment is to complete at least 5 assignments of what has been assigned there. **THE PURPOSE OF THIS ASSIGNMENT IS TO PRACTICE SPANISH DURING THE SUMMER SO THAT YOUR TRANSITION TO SPANISH CLASS GOES SMOOTH, THEREFORE, THE MORE YOU DO THE BETTER.**

If you would like extra opportunities to expose yourself to Spanish, there are many ways to creatively immerse oneself in the Spanish language through music and television. You can find them on Spanish television channels, Netflix, Hulu, YouTube, news programs, sports programs, etc... Just make sure that whatever you choose is set to Spanish audio and you can use English subtitles when watching. I recommend watching your favorite animated movie set to Spanish audio. Your **Spanish** class is going to use Duolingo at school. These are the instructions to join **Spanish 1 Honors 24-25!**

If you are on a computer, go here:

If you are on a smartphone or tablet:

1. Download the **Duolingo** app and open it up.
2. Press **Get Started**. Then select **Spanish**.
3. Set your Daily Goal and continue (you can change this later).
4. Create a Profile:
 -  On Android, press the menu icon at the top right corner and press **Create a Profile**.
 -  On iOS, press **Profile** in the top left corner and press **Create a Profile**.
5. Type in your **Name**, **Email** and **Password**, then press **Create**.
6. Go to your **Profile** and press **Progress Sharing**.
7. Type in your Classroom Code: **KCXEGX**
8. Press **Join Class**.
