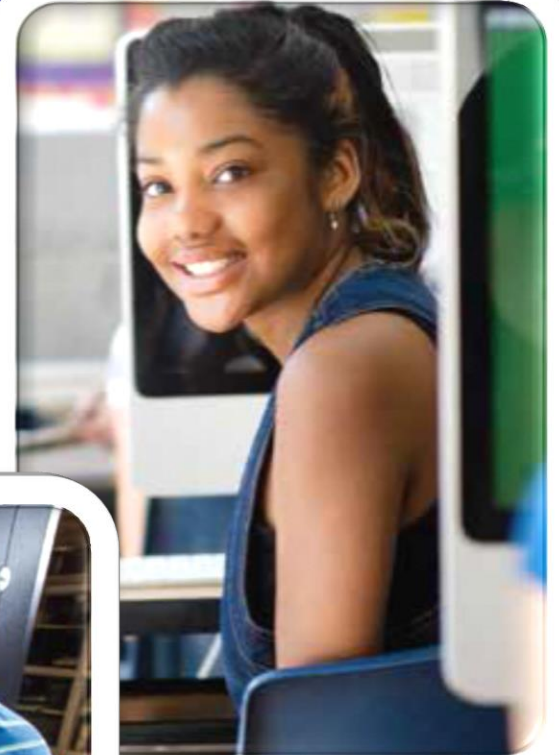
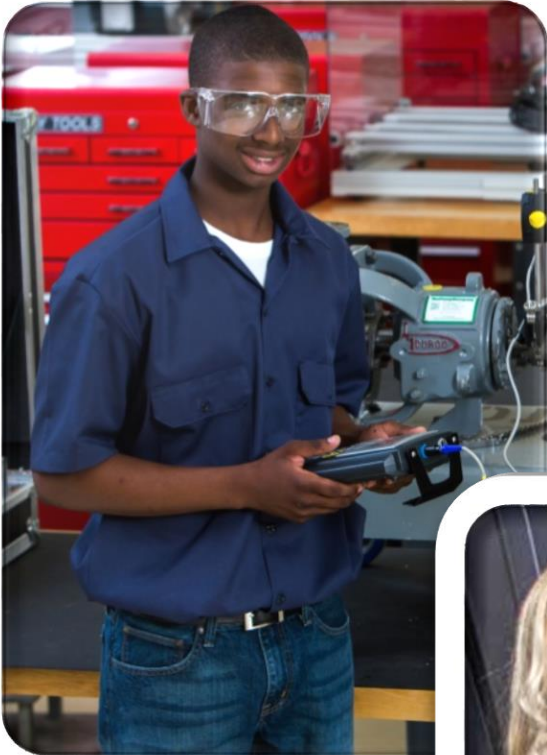

high school credit



# Impact of Dual Credit on High School Records

- Earn one unit toward the high school diploma for each three-semester-hour college course successfully completed
- Student performance in dual credit courses will directly affect high school records and graduation requirements in accordance with S.C. state policy

# Grading Procedures

- **TTC will report the earned numeric grade for each student to the high school**
- **Each institution will award final grades according to the applicable grading scales**

# Grading Procedures

## Trident Grading Scale

<b>A</b>	<b>91-100</b>
<b>B</b>	<b>81-90</b>
<b>C</b>	<b>71-80</b>
<b>D</b>	<b>65-70</b>
<b>F</b>	<b>Below 65</b>

## S.C. Uniform Grading Scale

<b>A</b>	<b>90-100</b>
<b>B</b>	<b>80-89</b>
<b>C</b>	<b>70-79</b>
<b>D</b>	<b>60-69</b>
<b>F</b>	<b>Below 60</b>

# Course Withdrawal Policy

- After the Drop/Add period, if a student chooses to withdraw from a TTC course:
  - A grade of “W” will appear on the TTC transcript
  - A numeric grade of “50” will be placed on the high school transcript

# Impact on LIFE Scholarship Eligibility

Grades in TTC courses impact your ability to earn and retain **LIFE** scholarships.

- **First Year** – Grades are calculated into the high school GPA used to determine eligibility.
- **Subsequent Years** – Grades are calculated as part of the ongoing College GPA used to determine continued eligibility.
  - 3.0 on 4.0 scale for all college grades earned at all eligible institutions



# Tuition & Fees

Students taking courses for dual credit are responsible for cost of tuition and books unless otherwise directed by high school or school district.

- **Lottery tuition assistance** is available for eligible students enrolled in 6 or more college credit hours during the same semester
- **Need-Based Scholarships** are available for high school students who qualify for free- or reduced- lunch programs

# Tuition Costs for 2018-2019

- Tuition and Fees

- \$188.69 per credit hour

- (3-credit-hour course = \$566.07)

- Some courses with labs will include additional lab fees



# Lottery Tuition Assistance 2019-20

- Students must be
  - SC resident (lived in SC for at least 1 year)
  - U.S. citizen
  - Enrolled in 6-credits during the same semester
- DC students do not need to file FAFSA
- Will cover roughly half of regular tuition (\$100 per credit hour)

# Need-Based Scholarships

## 2019-20

- Must qualify for free or reduced lunch based on traditional guidelines. Verification must be provided by school counselor
- Must be enrolled in 6 credit hours per semester
- Must maintain a college GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Scholarship includes all tuition and fees in excess of Lottery Tuition Assistance; does NOT include textbooks
