Four Ways to Take Part

- Bike to Work or School

Biking Tips

- **Helmet First:** Always wear a properly fitted helmet
- **Bike Check:** Ensure your bike is in good condition before riding
- **Stay Visible:** Wear bright clothing and use lights
- **Stay Alert:** Watch for traffic and avoid distractions
- **Ride Predictably:** Signal your turns and ride in a straight line
- **Stay Right:** Ride in the same direction as traffic
- **Practice Safety:** Prioritize safety on every ride
