They will also facilitate staff training and support for district approved technology platforms.

Major Duties and Responsibilities:

- Remains abreast of and continues to develop a knowledge of current instructional technology, new trends, and contemporary interpretations about the use of technology to enhance pupil learning in all content areas.
- Supports teachers in mastering integration of the New Jersey Student Learning Standards for technology and fostering the importance of technology literacy for success in the 21st century.
- Demonstrates the interpersonal, problem solving and organizational skills required to effectively facilitate peer coaching in the attainment of technology literacy at the levels established by the NJDOE, as required.
- Conducts a maximum of two one-hour training sessions per month

- Serves on District Technology and Professional Development Committees
- Facilitates staff training for district approved technology
- Collaborates with District Instructional Coach to identify need and plan professional development opportunities for assigned location
