

What is Leadership Class?

Purpose of the Class

The purpose of the ASB Leadership program is to create a memorable experience for all RHS students, to build unity and spirit among all people on campus, to provide support and resources to student groups on campus, and to develop student leaders who will transition into lifelong leaders.

Structure of the Class

- Students join for one semester at a time
 - Applications for Fall Semester open in April
 - Applications for Spring Semester open in November
- The class is made up of 60 Redwood students from each of the 4 grade levels
- Leadership meets Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 7:15-8:20 in room 182
- Tuesdays and Wednesdays students work in Committees, Thursdays are ASB Meetings
