The Counseling Department has hit the ground running and is focusing on assisting seniors with college applications. The college application process can be daunting for many, please assist in making this a positive experience by listening to and supporting your students. Feel free to visit our Senior Night Presentation, located on Tamalpais High School Counseling website, for assistance and information with this process. We counselors are also currently writing letters of recommendations for our seniors who are applying to colleges that require letters. If you are not sure if your college requires a letter, please visit the school's website and look under requirements.

Tam 9th graders are transitioning well into their classes, clubs and sports. We are currently conducting 9th grade meet and greets where each student has the opportunity to meet one on one with their counselor.

Students can sign up for the PSAT by visiting our website. We recommend all 11th grade students sign up. This practice test is a great opportunity for students to familiarize themselves with admissions testing. This official PSAT also pairs with Khan Academy allowing students to access personalized supports in the areas the student is most challenged in.

The counselors are revamping 10th grade presentations based on data from last year. We are looking forward to meeting with 10th graders and assisting them with preparing for future classes, balancing
