# One-on-one Mentoring

Can be **long term**, as an established relationship throughout a student's high school experience.

Can be **short term**, either as a one-time experience or over several meetings to accomplish a specific career exploration objective.

The mentor and student develop their own relationship based on the students' needs and wishes.

Activities together can include lunch/dinner/coffee together, volunteering, visiting the mentor's workplace.... the list is endless, really!



## Job Shadowing

Offers students experience & learning in their area of career interest while being out on the jobsite.

## Informational Interviewing

Utilized when job shadowing is restricted for circumstances relating to safety, confidentiality or impracticality.

Allows students to sit down with community professionals to talk about what to expect or what steps to take in order to enter the field of interest.
