Standardized Testing

The results of these tests provide a continuing record of each learner's academic progress in comparison with national and local norms. They are also an invaluable aid to the learner's facilitators and counselors in diagnosing individual strengths and needs in order to provide more effective individualized instruction. 



Graduation Pathways

The Pennsylvania Department of Education, has put into law Act 158, which alters the present graduation requirements to be less focused on statewide assessments but instead shift the focus to multiple college, career, and community readiness indicators. These pathways include a Keystone State Test proficiency pathway, however the other pathways allow for multiple options through pathways called an Alternate Pathway, Evidence Based Pathway, and a Career and Technical Education Pathway. We are encouraged by the shift in the graduation requirements focus, which align more closely to Pequea Valley's "Post Secondary First Choice" vision, customizing learning for learner's long-term goals.
