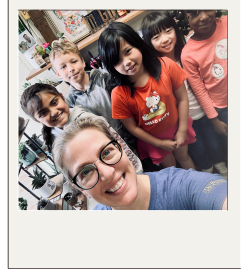
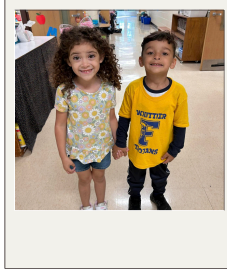

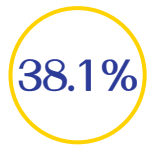

WHERE DO WE GET OUR FUNDING?

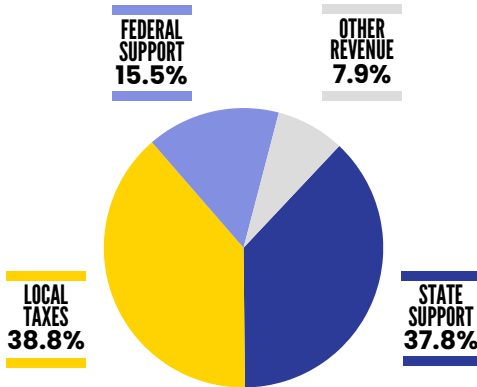
OHIO USES A **FORMULA** TO DETERMINE EACH DISTRICT'S FUNDING.

HOW DOES THE FORMULA WORK?

PROPERTY VALUES, INCOME OF RESIDENTS, & DISTRICT ENROLLMENT IS FACTORED BY THE STATE TO DETERMINE HOW WELL A COMMUNITY IS ABLE TO SUPPORT ITS DISTRICT.

General Fund Revenue, FY 2023

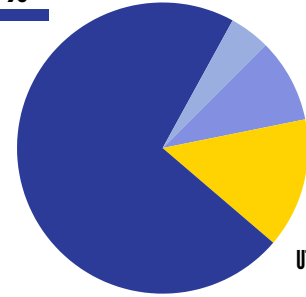

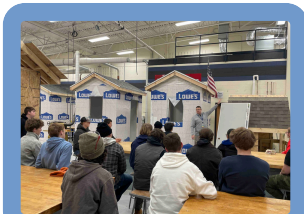

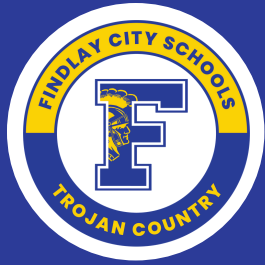


AWARDED THE OHIO CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION EQUIPMENT GRANT

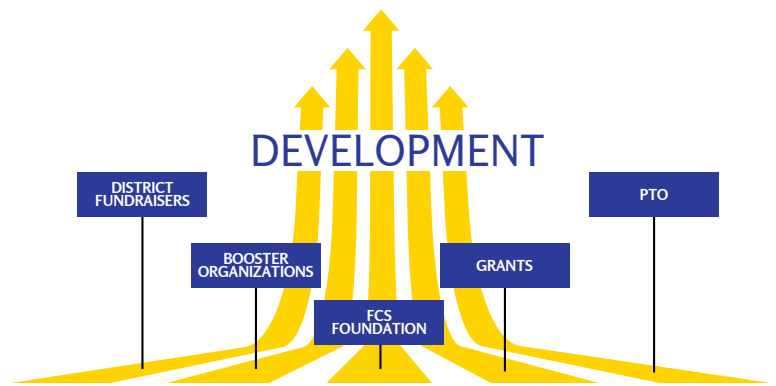
