Purpose: *This course focuses on acquiring the necessary organizational, study, and social skills for a successful ECHS and post-secondary experience.*

Objectives

- Maintain a weekly grade tracker and planner
- Pay for and register to take the PSAT (cost is \$18)
- Learn and practice how to effectively communicate (written and verbally)
- Create a portfolio
- Create a resume
- Compose Thank-You letters
- Explore ECHS's core values: responsibility, kindness, honesty, integrity, desire and respect
- Complete career inventories
- Learn and apply positive life values and characteristics/traits
- Research colleges and understand the basics regarding admissions and scholarships
- Attend mandatory tutorials if college or PATH grade requirements are not met (75/85 or above)
- Complete 20 hours of community service

Grading

Summative – 60% (writing assignments, tests, projects, etc.)

Formative – 40% (notebook/planner/grade-tracker checks, quizzes, daily work etc.)
