ABOUT THE COURSE

This course addresses all Algebra I Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) and provides the foundation for advanced mathematics courses in high school. The course focuses on algebraic thinking and symbolic reasoning that can be used to generalize mathematical situations; the relationship between equations and functions, and function concepts; representations, tools, and technology for expressing functions; and equations and the underlying mathematical processes of Algebra.

Canvas ONLINE ACCESS

Students will be accessing Canvas on a daily basis to participate in class, check for instructions, and occasionally to submit classwork. Be familiar with Canvas, and feel free to ask for help when you do not understand.

PHONES & DEVICES

LATE WORK/REDO
