Frequently Asked Questions:

1. How do I sign up for Dual Credit?

A student must successfully complete the prerequisite course and must have passed the TSIA2 in order to enroll in a math dual credit course. PSAT scores are also accepted, contact your counselor for more information.

2. Will this class affect my high school GPA?

The Midland College grade will not affect your high school. The grade might be different than your MISD grade.

3. Will my GPA transfer to other universities or colleges?

No, you will only transfer the courses and the hours.

4. Are Dual Credit Courses free?

No, every student must pay tuition to Midland College. Scholarships are available, ask your counselor for more information.

5. Will I have to do extra work if I am enrolled in Dual Credit?

Typically the students in the non dual credit courses and dual credit courses will do the same work, but it can vary from course to course.

6. Do I have to apply to Midland College?

Yes, every student enrolled in dual credit courses is a Midland College student.
