

# What is in the help guide tab?



In the Help Guide, you will see this overview image along with detailed charts pertaining to all of the tools available. These charts will define the use of each tool. There are two types of test tools available:

**Global Tools:** These tools appear in the global menu or “test tools” at the top of the test page. These tools do vary between tests.

**Context Menu Tools:** These tools are for passages and questions. To use these tools, click the context menu found below the global tools.
