


Overall Campus Quality: Comparison by Respondent Type




Dimension Scores: Comparison by Respondent Type











Safety and Behavior: Comparison by Respondent Type












Parent-Teacher Conference Days: Comparison Over Time






How likely is it that you would recommend your child's campus to a family member or friend? (N=36)


How likely is it that you would recommend your campus to a family member or friend? (N=15)




