

LCHS Booster Club Mission Statement

Section 1.01 Purpose The purpose of the LCHS Booster Club is to promote athletics at Labette County High School in an atmosphere that is consistent with the educational philosophy of the school community.

Section 1.02 Objectives The objectives of the Club are as follows:

(a) Develop an organization with an active and involved membership that is concerned with the total athletic program and all of its participants regardless of sex, race, socio-economic status or chosen sports activity.

(b) Promote school spirit and sportsmanship and encourage attendance at all LCHS athletic events.

(c) Aid the LCHS staff in organizing and staging athletic events and special projects.

(d) Aid and support LCHS staff in the areas of sports promotion, publicity, and program development.

(e) Provide supplementary financial support for the various athletic activities Labette County High School.

Section 1.03

1. Supplementary financial support will be provided in the following manner and for the following items:

All special request items from LCHS Coaching Staff purchased will be voted on according to LCHS Booster Club Rules. Items requested by an LCHS Coach will be requested on a LCHS Booster Club Request Form that will be submitted to the Booster Club via the Athletic Director. The AD will receive a reply from the BC and relay that to the respective coach.

Items for Purchase

(a) Hard Goods (equipment) for the athletic teams not normally purchased by USD 506. Hard Goods will be decided on a case by case request with the AD and Booster Club voting officers.

(b) Awards Banquets/Banners and Plaques for student athletes.

(c) Recognition of Student Athletics in local media.

(d) Travel meals for teams while traveling together under LCHS Supervision and competing at an LCHS sanctioned athletic event during the school year. This meal will be limited to one per team each year and be purchased at the discretion of the AD, LCHS Booster Club and respective Coach.

(d) Any items or equipment the Booster Club Officers deem necessary for further Booster Club Operations-including but not limited to concessions equipment/stock/and or accessories to maintain game concession.

(e) Any merchandise for re-sale or promotional items to be handed out.

Section 1.05

(a) Vote on items can be done at meetings, via email, or phone. A record of such vote will be submitted to the secretary for record.

(b) Officers ordering for concessions will not be required to get a vote on purchase of items ordered for concessions.

(c) In the event a vote cannot be obtained, purchase of merchandising items up to \$1,000 may be made as long as at least 2 officers are in agreement to purchase said items.
