Dear Parents,

You may have heard about measles cases recently confirmed in Texas. We want to assure you that as of now, no cases of measles have been confirmed in Midland County. Our district health department, including all campus nurses, are actively monitoring the situation to make sure our students remain safe and healthy.

A higher than average percentage of our students are immunized against measles. However, for those parents who have not had their child fully vaccinated, we urge you to visit your family physician to make sure all immunizations are up to date. If your student is not fully immunized against measles for any reason, including exemptions, they will be excluded from campus for a minimum of 21 days after each exposure.

The Centers for Disease Control offers information and recommendations on how to keep you and your kids safe.

Thank you for your continued support of Midland ISD and our efforts to make sure all students have a safe and healthy learning environment.
