
WHEREAS, the Board of Directors authorizes the Superintendent of Schools to contract with each County Judge on behalf of the Board for the purpose of administering the elections;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors authorizes the County Judge from Hidalgo, Cameron, and Willacy counties, to administer the South Texas Independent School District elections, including the selection of Election Judges, the location of early voting booths, and the location of voting booths for each precinct on election day, according to former Chapter 26, Texas Education code, Section 26.31, provisions for elections, as continued in effect by Texas Education Code 11.301.
