Frequently Asked Questions about the E-Rate Program and Donations

*Remember, all donations (with regards to E-Rate) must get <u>prior</u> approval before acceptance. CDC (Local)

1. Are "in-kind" goods or services considered a donation?

Answer: Yes

2. Do "in-kind" goods or services need to be reported?

Answer: Yes

3. How should "in-kind" goods or services be reported?

Answer: "In kind" goods or services should be reported in the same manner as all donations. However, a dollar value does need to be assessed and reported.

4. How do I know when I need to report a donation with regards to E-Rate?

Answer: If donation is technology, worth \$5,000 or more, it must be approved PRIOR to acceptance.

Answer: ALL donations (of ANY value), from an E-Rate Vendor, <u>must</u> have prior approval before acceptance.
