

SUPPLEMENTAL PAY

HIGH SCHOOL FRESHMAN/JV CHEERLEADER AGREEMENT

FULL-TIME PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES WITH A TEACHING CERTIFICATION WILL BE CONSIDERED ELIGIBLE FOR THE FRESHMAN/JV CHEERLEADER STIPEND WHO:

- 1. Attend at least one cheerleading camp per year with the Freshman and JV Cheerleading squads
- 2. Attend all athletic events as designated by the campus principal
- Provide students and parents who are assisting your group with a school identification badge, designating them as volunteers
- 4. Provide students the opportunity to attend club meetings and practice for competitions throughout the school year utilizing both on-campus scheduling and at-home virtual platforms such Zoom and Teams
- 5. Conduct cheerleading tryouts for the following year during the spring semester
- 6. Complete required CPR class successfully along with any other additional required training
- 7. Complete all other cheerleading sponsor requirements as designated by the campus principal
- 8. Attend scheduled trainings. If training falls outside the normal contract hours, the time will be compensated at the district approved professional training rate.
- Manage/keep inventory and store all equipment and supplies purchased by the Dallas ISD Student Activities Department.
- 10. Verify all students are academically eligible to compete meaning students are passing all classes
- 11. Adhere to all district policies, including at least one adult chaperone for every 10 students for school related trips
- 12. Sponsors must have student emergency contact information in their possession at the site of the event/competition.
- 13. Make sure all volunteers complete the online volunteer application at https://dallasisd.voly.org/
- 14. Complete all field trip paperwork required by campus and district

ANNUAL STIPEND (\$2,300)

- Supplemental pay of \$2,300 will be added to your monthly paycheck in 12 equal installments. (\$191 a month)
- If any required event is not entered and performed, and approval not to enter has not been granted (in advance), a formal letter will be sent to your principal.
