Action	Person Responsible	Day	Description
Opening Session	Principal	Day 1	Welcome, introductions, program overview and history, expectations for week.
College Enrollment & TSI Pre-Assessment Video	Caldwell	Day 1	Students complete online enrollment application for El Centro College. The TSI Pre-Assessment Video is a requirement by the college. The video informs students of the purpose of the TSI assessment as well as what to expect on the test. Sample problems are available as practice.
Session: TSI Reading Prep	Aguilar, Hart	Day 1	Students participate in activities designed to familiarize them with TSI Reading topics and questions as well as test taking strategies for TSI.
Campus Tour & Student Organization Walkabout	Organization members	Day 1	Students will receive a guided tour (small groups) of the El Centro College campus and will be able to visit booths from each student organization on campus.
Enrollment Packets / Remind for Textbooks / Graphing Calculator / School Supply List	Caldwell	Day 1	Students will receive college enrollment packets, join the Remind 101 textbook group, graphing calculator contract, and school supply lists.
Debrief Activity	Student Ambassadors	Day 1	Time is allocated to allow students to ask clarifying questions regarding information received on Day 1.
TSI Reading Assessment	Caldwell, Kuilan	Day 2	Students take the TSI Reading assessment.
Student Performances	Various	Day 2	Students are treated to performances from the Glee Club and Dance Crew.
Session: TSI Writing Prep	Aguilar	Day 3	Students participate in activities designed to familiarize them with TSI Writing topics and questions. Exemplars are reviewed. Students practice with a prompt and receive feedback.
Session: Early College 101	Alexander, Marlin	Day 3	Students receive information regarding degree plans, credits, eCampus & eConnect, College Advising, Withdrawals/Drops, Professor office hours, etc.

Session: Discipline & Safety	Assistant Principal	Day 3	Students receive information regarding behavior expectations on a college campus, the differences between the DISD and DCCCD student code of conduct as well as common sense safety issues while on a college campus in downtown Dallas.
Session: Academic Behaviors	Principal	Day 3	This presentation is derived from the book "Getting Ready for College, Careers, and the Common Core" by David J. Conley. Academic Behaviors such as Ownership of Learning, Goal Setting, Persistence, Self-Awareness, Motivation, Help-Seeking, and Progress Monitoring are discussed and why they are important to success in higher education.
