^ Select eighteen (18) credit hours that include EDUC 1300 or any college credit courses other than those with the prefix of BIOL, CHEM, ENGR, ENVR, GEOL, MATH, PHYS, or ANTH 2401. If a student successfully completes EDUC 1300 or PSYC 1300, the student will only be required to complete a total of 15-credit hours of electives. Courses previously taken cannot be used to satisfy both the Core and the requirement for this elective. *Life and Physical Sciences courses selected in Stage 3 cannot be used to also satisfy Life and Physical Sciences requirement in Stage 2. This requirement cannot be met using the following combinations: BIOL 1406 and BIOL 1408; BIOL 1407 and BIOL 1409; BIOL 2420 and 2421; CHEM 1405 and 1411; CHEM 1406 and 1411; CHEM 1405 and 1406; CHEM 1406 and CHEM 1407; GEOL 1401 and GEOL 1403; PHYS 1401 and PHYS 1405; PHYS 1401 and 2425; PHYS 1405 and 2425. + If MATH 1314 is completed and expected to count as the 4th year HS math graduation credit, MATH 1316 is needed as well. NOTE: Courses designated by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board as workforce education (technical) courses offered for credit and CEUs (Continuing Education Units). While these courses are designed to transfer among state community colleges, they are not designed to automatically transfer to public four-year colleges and universities.
