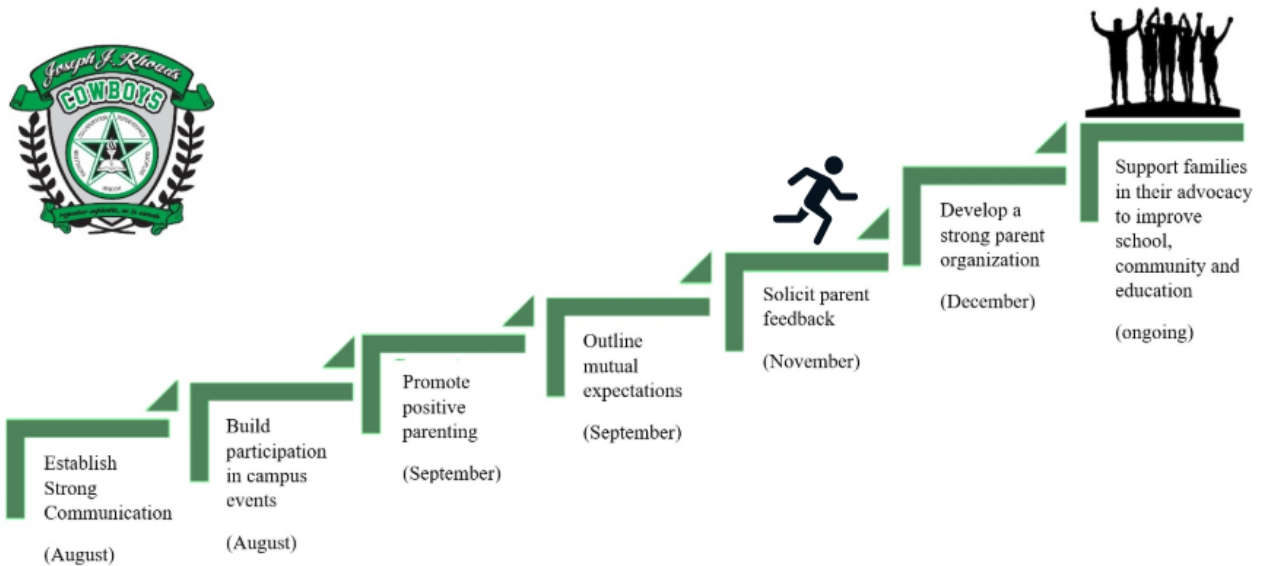




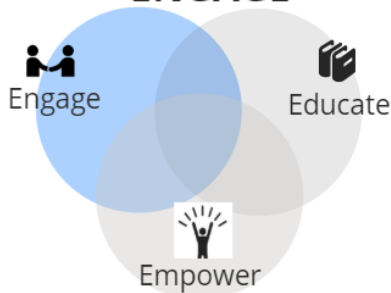

## THE 3 KEY ELEMENTS

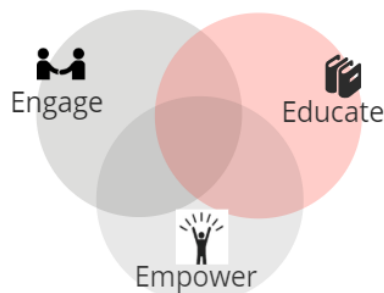
### ENGAGE

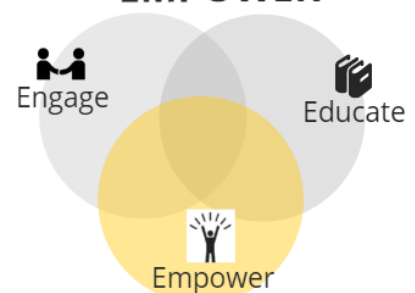
### EDUCATE
