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

Independent Reading

- In Kindergarten a lot of scores are based on listening comprehension.
- In first grade scores are based on independent reading comprehension.

Numbers

 In Kindergarten scholars compose and decompose numbers. In First grade we look at numbers through the place value lens and work on mathematical fluency.


Writing

 In Kindergarten scholars write 1-3 sentences. In first grade scholars write at least a paragraph with proper letter formation, spacing, proper grammar, and punctuation.

4 things you can do to prepare for 1st Grade

Reading/Writing

- Handwriting: Correct Letter formation
- Read 20 min. daily

What else can I do to help during the summer?

- Review complete sentences
 - Practice writing complete sentences
 - Starts with capital letter, has noun and verb, ends with a punctuation mark
 - For example: "I like to eat.", "The car is blue."

**Recommended that Dual Language classes complete these activities in language of instruction: Spanish.

Do we need to submit a health history form every year for allergies. No, only if there are any changes.

Will girls who have completed ST Math for 1st grade have to start over. We are currently working with the vendor to figure this out and will reach out to you as soon as we get an answer. We are hoping they will not have to start over.

How are the math groupings determined, monitored, and how often do they change? Before the start of every math unit, scholars will take a pre-assessment. We will use the data to create groups (ability) across the grade level. These groups will change every 4-5 weeks depending on the unit. We will end every unit with a post-assessment to measure growth.

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
