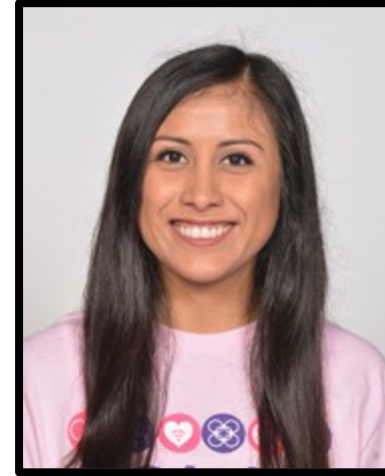

Why the Jump from Second to Third Grade is the Biggest Leap Your Child Will Make

For children, advancing to the next grade in school always brings a little nervousness and excitement – and maybe a little confusion. The jump from second to third grade, however, is about a lot more than social jitters and getting used to a new classroom. Although it has been said that odd years and transitional years (elementary to middle school, middle school to high school) are difficult, most educators believe 3rd grade is the biggest leap a child will make during his or her school years.

Gradual Release

The goal is for students to be **CONFIDENT**, independent and self-sufficient when it comes to their goals, learning and tasks.

What we have learned from experience/feedback:

- Content is brand-new to students
- Expectation of independence and self-reliance
- Faster pace, higher rigor
- The second six weeks is often the most challenging
- It takes time to adjust

Questions:

- **Does the playlist included in the slides represent at-home learning or in school learning?**

This is a playlist for in school, however students use an online playlist for virtual learning.

- **How will students with special needs like dyslexia be served if school is back in session and parents decide to keep their kids at home?**

As a school we will always prioritize access for all students, but the district is currently sending out surveys to gather more information and data, and we can provide more information about what school might look like and what policies will be in place in the next few weeks.

- **Why are there five teachers but only four sections?**

At Solar we value targeted, differentiated support and coaching for our teachers in the same way we value this type of teaching and learning for our students. Ms. Kyle is going to be an instructional lead teacher. She will be teaching one class and spend the rest of her time coaching teachers across the entire campus.
