Nancy Moseley Elementary operates on the premise that all of our students have a right to learn and every teacher has the right to teach. If students are to develop into “life-long learners and productive members of society” each must learn the art of self-discipline.

Inappropriate behaviors at Nancy Moseley Elementary fall into 3 categories or level of offenses stated in the Dallas ISD Student Code of Conduct Handbook. A list of those offenses is listed below for your reference. Please keep in mind that this list is not all-inclusive, and is only meant to provide examples of Level 1-4 offenses. Please see the Student Code of Conduct for a complete list.
