Leader in Me Internship

Martin Weiss School of Leadership is excited to launch our 2015-2016 Leadership Mentoring Program. Martin Weiss recently earned the choice school distinction within the Dallas Independent School District. Nestled in the heart of the Oak Cliff community, Martin Weiss Elementary services 527 students. Our diverse learning community is comprised of 72% Hispanic students, 26% African American students, and 2% other. Additionally, 99% of our student population is economically disadvantaged. Many of our students will be the first in their family to graduate college.

Though our students face many environmental and economic challenges, we know that education is the great equalizer. The number of first generation college graduates is on the rise, but these students often struggle to enter their chosen career fields due to limited exposure. The goal for this program is to proactively create a supportive community network for our children, to ensure that each of our qualifying 5th graders has exposure to a network of exemplary leaders. This will give them the skills, support, and advocacy needed to be successful leaders in middle-school, college, and beyond.

Currently, we are recruiting mentors to work with our young leaders. We are seeking to enhance their skill set by pairing them with exemplary professionals and community leaders for a Leadership Internship. During this internship, we want each of our students to observe ways to embody the character, conduct, and conversation of a leader in real world situations.

To serve as a mentor, we require a complete DISD background check and completion of a mentoring training session that can be scheduled upon receipt of a complete application.

As a mentor we will ask you to commit to the following activities:

Activity 1: Arrange to meet with your mentee at least three times on our campus.

Activity 2: Arrange one "Day in the Life" opportunity for your mentee to observe you leading in your career/ community.

Activity 3: Speak at one of our Leadership Symposiums, or career day.
