Code of Conduct for Athletic & Special Events

Dallas ISD Police & Security Services and the Dallas ISD Athletic Department, have implemented the following stadium and gymnasium guidelines in an effort to ensure a safe and secure family-oriented environment for athletic and special events:

Male(s) over the age of ten (10) wearing a sleeveless tank top T-shirt will not be allowed entry into a stadium and/or gymnasium for any athletic and/or special event.

Males wearing do-rags/bandannas or beads will be asked to remove the items or be denied entry into a stadium and/or gymnasium, and, if entry is gained the individual will be asked to remove the item(s) or be removed from the facility

Females wearing skimpy shorts, hot pants, or micro-mini skirts will not be allowed entry into a stadium and/or gymnasium of any athletic and/or special event.

Females wearing sexually revealing garment exposing their cleavages or buttocks will not be allowed entry into a stadium and/or gymnasium.

No one wearing garments with explicit writings and/or drawings supporting the use of drugs, gangs, or violence will be allowed entry into a stadium or gymnasium.

At the discretion of the supervising Police Lieutenant, Sergeant, or Stadium Team Leader, anyone wearing clothing that has the resemblance of gang apparel will be denied entry onto (or subject them to removal from) any Dallas ISD property or stadium and/or gymnasium, to include, but not limited to all district parking lots.

Unless special circumstances warrant, no one will be given "in and out" privileges to any athletic and/or special event.

Contraband, including drugs, alcohol, tobacco products or weapons of any kind, will not be allowed on any Dallas ISD property to include parking lots.

Video cameras will not be allowed in football or basketball games playoffs or non-district sponsored athletic and/or special events.

No tickets will be sold at the beginning of the fourth quarter of the last scheduled game of the day.

At the beginning of the fourth quarter of any stadium and/or gymnasium event, entry into the stadium or school parking lot will only be granted to individuals who are picking up spectators.

Since there are weekday and weekend night curfews for students, they should make transportation arrangements at least 30 minutes prior to the end of each event.

All individuals operating a motor vehicle on Dallas ISD property must have a valid drivers' license and proof of current liability insurance in their possession.

After the parking lot has been cleared of all vehicles, any remaining spectators will be instructed to wait outside the parking lot or stadium premises for their transportation.
