The English Department at North Lake Early College High School is pleased to announce the required reading for this upcoming school year. The 9th grade level reading expectations are as follows:

  - 1. 19 Minutes by Jodi Picoult (Must be bought on your own.)
  - 2. Scythe by Neal Shusterman (Must be bought on your own.)
