As of August 25, 2022, Dallas ISD no longer recommends Quarantine.

Regardless of vaccination status or past infection, quarantine is NO LONGER RECOMMENDED for persons who were exposed to Covid-19. Students and staff who were exposed to Covid-19 should:

- Monitor for symptoms of Covid (fever, cough, fatigue) daily
- If symptoms develop, DO NOT report to school/work. Get tested as soon as possible.
- Get tested for Covid 5 days after exposure if no symptoms develop
- The CDC recommends wearing a mask indoors for up to 10 days from the last day of exposure

If you test positive for Covid, STAY HOME and let the school nurse know. The nurse will provide you with a return-to-school date, which will be 5 days after the first positive test. Return-to-school is based on improvement of symptoms.
