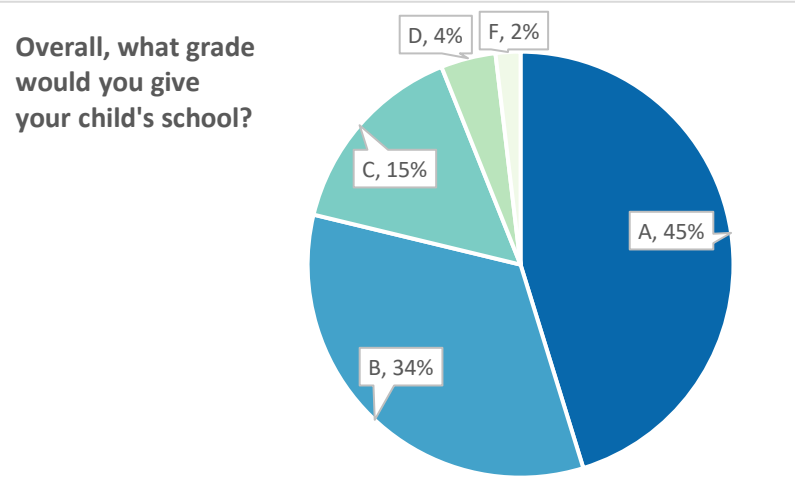

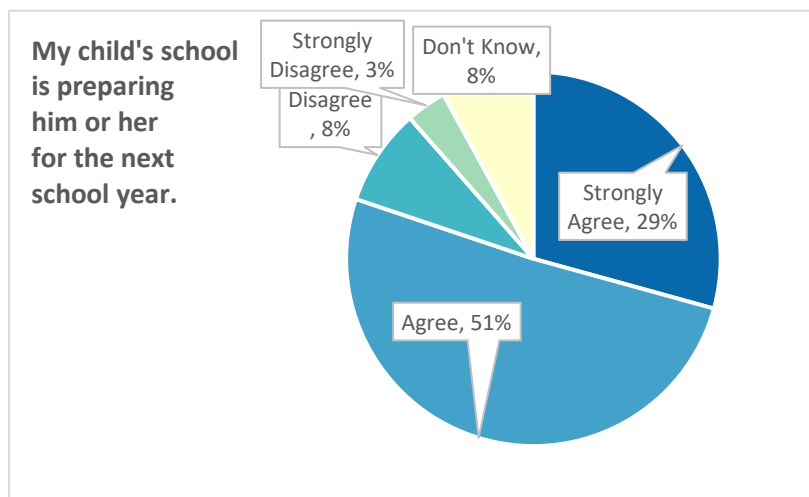
Overall, what grade would you give your child's school?

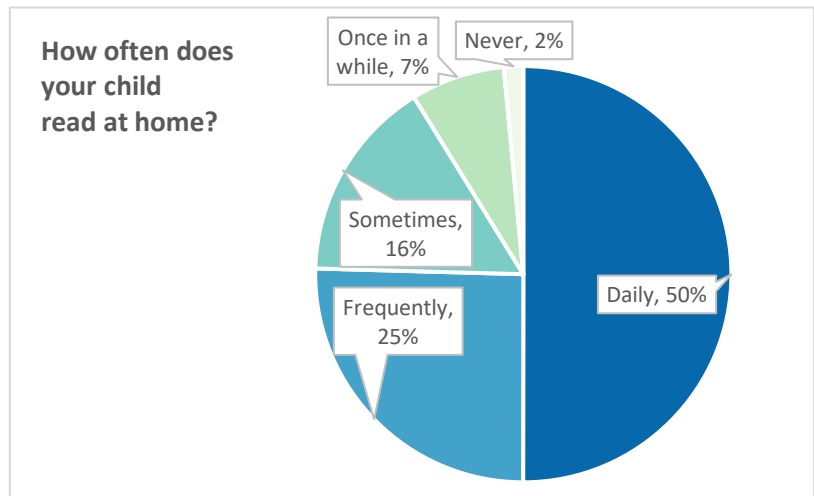

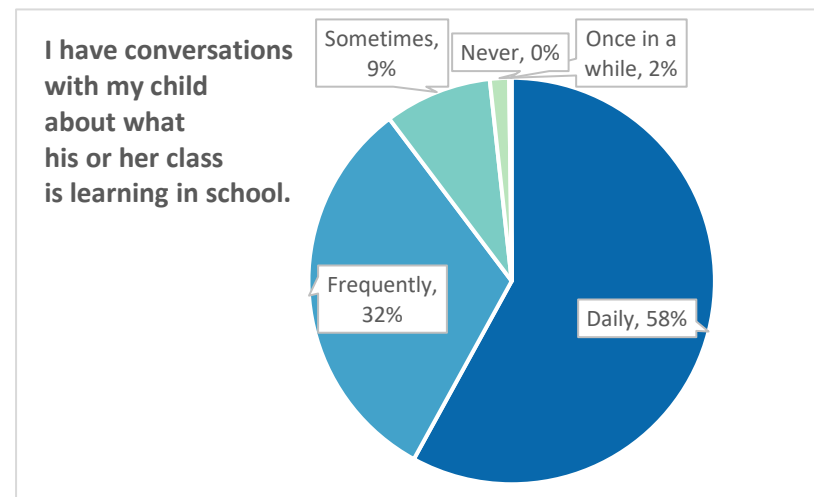
How often does your child read at home? (Include both assigned readings and choice readings.)

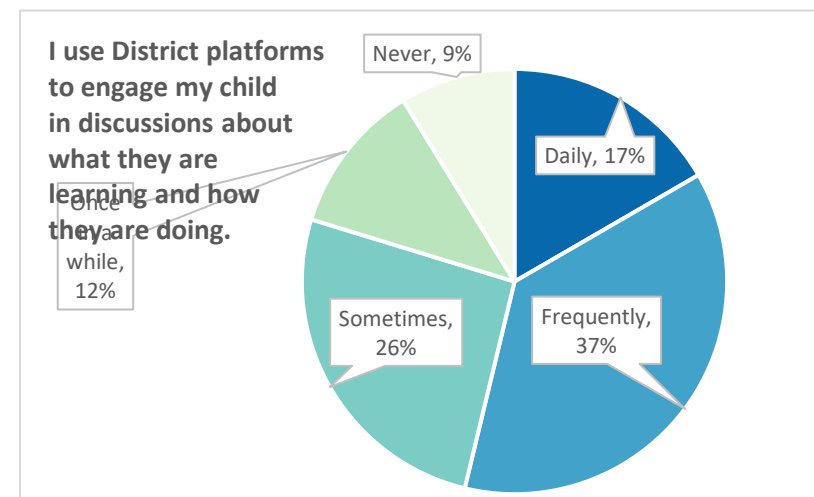

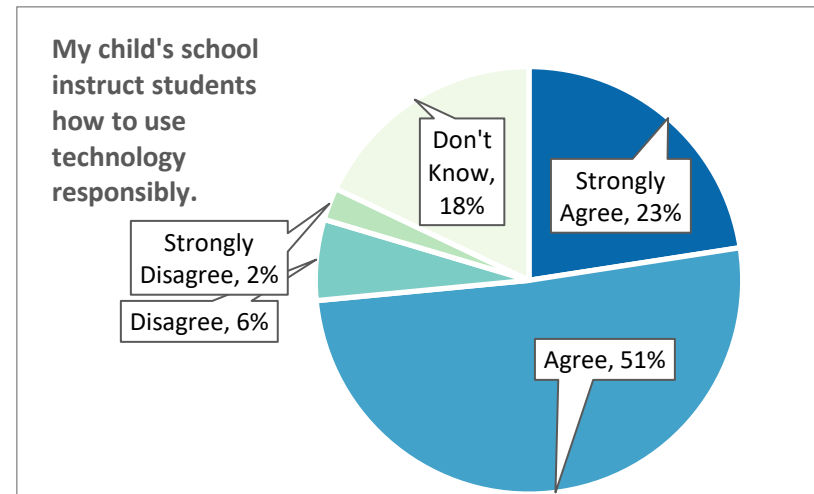

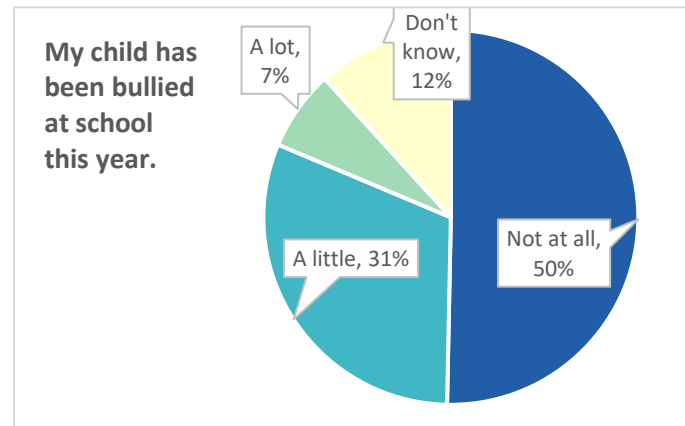

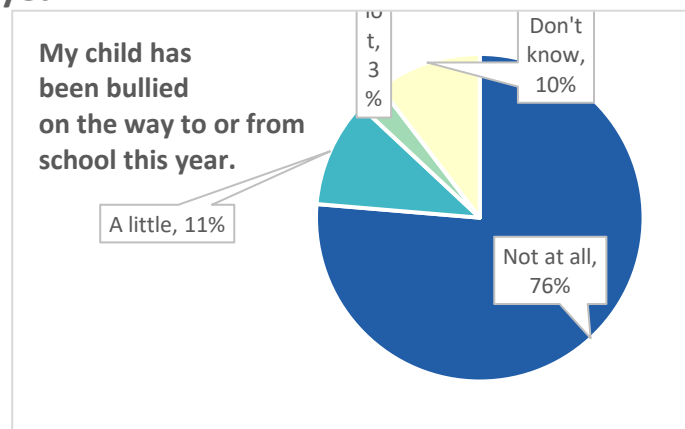

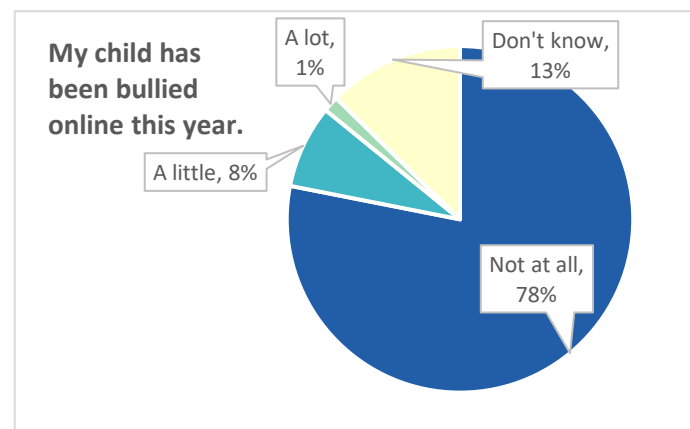
My child has been bullied on the way to or from school this year.

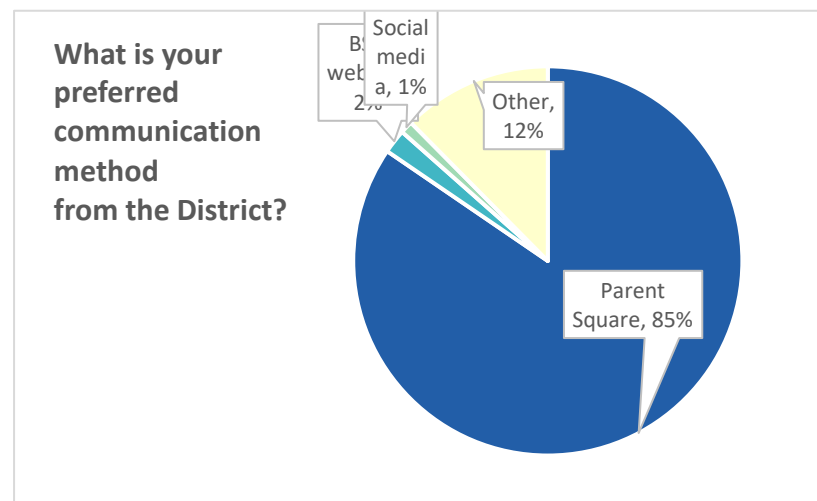
