Motion to approve the agenda as written, seconded and passed.

Val provided the group with the Vermont Continuous Improvement Plan handout. This is required by the AOE biannually and will be submitted this year upon approval. There are 3 goals in our plan. 1) Safe and Healthy Schools: By June 2027, students and adults will be aware of biases and privileges and learn how to address them. This will be done through professional development and a continuation of things already being worked on like the ExPeRT document. 2) Academic Achievement: By June 2027, all LNSU schools will implement coordinated curriculum using high-quality instruction. 3) Academic Achievement Part 2: By June 2027, educators will understand and apply practices and strategies of proficiency-based learning. Students and parents/caregivers will receive support in understanding proficiency-based learning as well as the expectations of requirements, grading, and assessments.

Diane commented on the importance of goal #1 and how vital having common plans and language throughout the district is; this will benefit students and adults district wide.

Val updated the group on our new software, Infinite Campus; this should go live by August 1st.

There will be a lot of professional development at the closing of the school year. This is a great opportunity for collaboration among educators.

Val asked the group to bring forward a motion to approve the CIP at the board meeting immediately following. She will give a brief summary of the plan at the meeting. The group agreed to make the motion.
