- 2) Attendance/Introductions Kevin Tubbs, Sam Heiden, Kristie Moder, Patrick Lee, Dave Christianson, Gregg Syring, Julia Squier, Todd Schultz (father of Charlie Schultz)
- Approval of November Minutes Dave motioned to approve November minutes, Gregg 2<sup>nd</sup>; passed unanimously
- **4) Enrollment Update (Patrick)** currently at 50 students and unaware of any students leaving at semester; one freshman will be starting FCLA at semester
- 5) Application live Dec 1 / status of applications and follow-up swag for applicants?; do we place the order for t-shirts, lanyards, decals, etc. and create store for current students to order (Kevin has 2 resources he will look into)
- 6) Marketing/Student Recruitment
  - a) **Shadow Days –** 25 students show up for first shadow day and 15 already applied excellent day with engaged students; Dec 14<sup>th</sup> is the next shadow with 3 sign ups currently; Kristie had 4 parent outreach questions common questions regarding are they part of North, grading, transcripts, etc, so Heather suggested creating a video with FAQ post on homepage; FAQ page is already on the website; questions regarding school choice within AASD can be referred to guidance registrar; open enrollment outside the district is addressed on the website under the application tab for new families
  - b) School Visits students have attended all middle schools and Kristie has reached out to all counselors at each middle school; Sophia is student coordinating school visits and shadow days as her senior capstone project/internship – doing an excellent job; time limited during ACP time at middle schools
  - c) Charter School Fair evaluation Patrick attended at Appleton East; spoke to about 10 families; better to have the date in November rather than January
