Step 6:

Select the Actions



Address appropriate data-driven actions and measurable relevant goals.

Guiding Questions

- What actions will need to be taken to address the identified learning needs?
- What does the research say about the effectiveness of the strategies and actions chosen?
- What interventions such as re-teaching, RtI, after school tutoring, computer-aided tutoring, etc. should be implemented?
- What will each campus member do to increase the level of student proficiency?
- Have SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, and Timely) goals been set?
- What additional data should be explored to verify explanations?
- What other information needs to be known?

Do It Yourself

Example: Across content levels, focused vocabulary development should be implemented.

Example: During after school tutoring, teachers will implement additional instructional strategies not used during the day.
