



Please review the [Hutto ISD Homeschool and Extracurricular Participation FAQ for Parents](#) prior to beginning the process of enrolling your homeschooled child for UIL participation.

Before Practice Participation

- Parent email/call Program Director to initiate Homeschool Conversation (Program Director initiates conversation about living in Hutto ISD Boundary Lines)
- Student MUST complete grade-level proficiency testing prior to submitting an enrollment application to Hutto ISD. (See step 5 of FAQ's) This documentation must be provided in the online enrollment application under "Other Documentation".
- Family completes New Student Online Registration in Skyward Family Access and provides all required documentation. Registration instructions: <https://www.hipponation.org/page/9318>
- The registrar will process the application and enroll the student as a "Zero Member" if they are attending school for less than 2 hours/day. If the student is enrolling to the Hutto Virtual Academy, their enrollment will be completed through that program. (PEIMS/Campus Registrar)
- Using Skyward School ID #, Complete Rank One Forms (which includes our student-handbook signature) Before August 1st.
- *Complete and Submit Athletic Physical Before August 1st, if required. [Athletic Physical Information and Form to Print](#)
- Provide documentation of Home School Program enrollment for the current school year.

Before Game/Event Participation

- Home Visit for proof of residency in Hutto ISD. (This will be done by the Program Director)
- *For Athletics the family completes a PAPF (Previous Athletic Participation Form) with Athletic Director for all student-athletes in grades 9-12, for athletic participation only.
- Program Director will email the Coordinator, Campus Staff and Campus Principal when the above is complete verifying all steps have been completed for participation.

Parental Information and Acknowledgement

- [Grading periods](#) (3 week progress report, and 6 week report card) supplied by Hutto ISD to parents of homeschooled student UIL participants. (provided by PEIMS/Campus Registrar)

- A Skyward ID and Badge ID will be created for identification on Hutto ISD Campuses - to be worn at all times. (PEIMS/Safety and Security)

- Parent Responsibility** to provide eligible grades to Hutto ISD at 3 weeks and 6 weeks mark to prove athletic eligibility. If not provided, practice and participation stops immediately.

- Parent Responsibility** to monitor student-athlete and/or fine arts activities away from Hutto ISD practices and games/participation. *“Students playing in UIL cannot participate in Homeschool Leagues as well. According to UIL rules, students cannot get extra coaching from a private coach during regular school hours. Doing so will result in the student being disqualified from competition and possibly causing the team to forfeit any victories. Just like fully enrolled students, non-enrolled students can receive private lessons after school hours”*

- Parent Responsibility** will pay \$55.00 + service fees toward equipment provided by Hutto ISD. \$50 will be returned, at the end of the school year, provided the equipment is returned in good condition. If equipment is not returned and exceeds the deposit amount, the parent/student will be responsible to pay the difference of the actual cost for the items not returned. The deposit will not be needed if the student is using his/her own equipment approved by the director.
