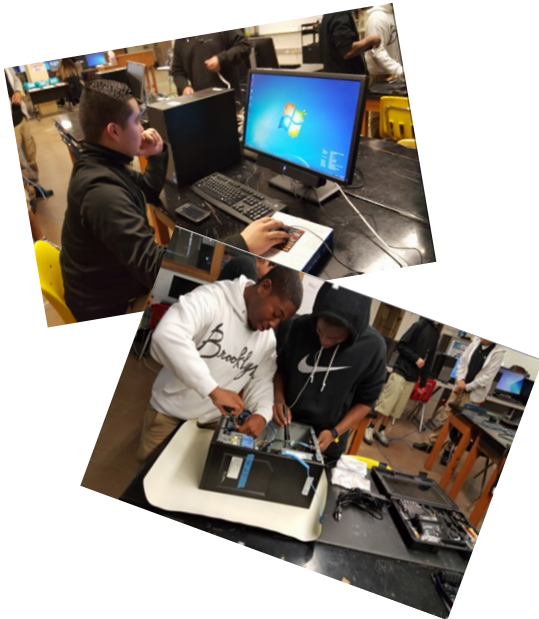




IT Academy

Students in the Academy of Information Technology (AOIT) will take one class each year of high school. Our current pathway is Computer Information Systems with contingent additional courses as academy grows. Students will be eligible to graduate with a NAF Certification upon completion of required course work.



Information Technology Track

◆ 9th Grade—Principles of Information Technology

In this course, students acquire advanced skills in creating documents, spreadsheets, database, presentations and graphic media using Microsoft Applications.

◆ 10th Grade—Computer Systems

Students gain know of various computer systems and how they work as well as hands-on experience in computer repair.

◆ 11th Grade—Computer Networking or Web Design

Computer Networking provides a hands-on approach to computer equipment installation and network set-up, as well as cloud technology.

Web Design provides a hands-on introduction to design, building, and launching websites.

◆ 12th Grade—Database Design or Graphic Design

Database Design students gain skills using solutions based model to solve real world problems using technology.

Graphic Design provides a hands-on introduction to creative skills of a professional graphic designer.
