ENROLLMENT CRITERIA

H. Grady Spruce Early College High School is designed to serve incoming ninth-grade students who are:

- Determined to attend college.
- First Generation college students.
- Historically underrepresented in higher education.

The academy will accept up to 125 ninth-grade students per year, and students will move together as a cohort as they progress through high school.
